

Elementary Clicker Training Class ***Class Description***

The Elementary Clicker Training Class is a 6-week class designed to teach people how to train their dogs to do basic behaviors including: sit, down, stand, heel, walk on a leash, come, stay, leave-it, and off. In addition, we discuss how to deal with issues such as jumping up on people, rushing out doors, digging, barking and chewing.

The focus of this class is for the dogs to learn to pay attention to their people as opposed to all the other dogs and distractions in the class. This is a great beginning level training class for dogs older than 18 weeks. Ideally, clients start with a Puppy Preschool then take a Puppy Enrichment before moving into Elementary Clicker Training. I find that the dogs and people, who have taken a previous clicker class, benefit even more from this class. However, if that is not possible, this is a good beginning-level training class.

The Elementary Clicker Class is also the basic class required before clients move on to more advanced training classes such as Clicker High, Musical Canine Freestyle, Rally-O or Agility.
