Are you ready to add the cue? Try transitioning the hand signal to add the verbal cue

Basic Behaviors

Targeting – Hand Target – “Touch”

Review the instructions for “touch” in *Click ‘n Connect*. Start working on targeting this week by teaching your dog to touch your hand. This is a really fun behavior, and there are lots of fun things to teach your dog with it as we go on.

Leave it/take it

Continue working with your Leave it/Take it. If your dog is getting proficient, go ahead and add the cue “leave-it” as your dog backs away from your closed hand.

Recall – “Come”

Ping-Pong Puppy – The Relay Game

Begin teaching your dog to come when called this week by using the Ping Pong Puppy game demonstrated in class:

- Step 1 – run between 2 people
- Step 2 – add the cue when your dog is readily running between 2 people

Loose Leash Walking

Rapid Rate of Reinforcement – Review “Let’s Walk” in *Click ‘n Connect*. Try using a rapid rate of reinforcement as demonstrated in class to begin teaching your dog to walk on a loose leash
